Publication Schedule

Lubes'n'Greases magazine publishes on or around the first of each month.

Deadlines

See the *Lubes'n'Greases* editorial calendar for material deadlines.

Ad File Checklist

- High-resolution PDF file, minimum 300 dpi.
- CMYK color only. No RGB.
- Fonts embedded in all subsets.
- For all full-page ads, set page size to equal bleed dimensions (8 5/8 inches wide x 11 1/8 inches high).
- For all full-page ads, set trim box to finished dimensions (8 3/8 inches wide x 10 7/8 inches high).
- Remove crop marks or registration marks.
- Advertorial includes the word "Advertisement" in legible, 9 point font centered at the top of each page.
- Advertisers are responsible for ensuring QR codes and URLs in ads direct to live sites prior to publication.
- Contact Lubes'n'Greases for sending instructions for files that are 10 MB or larger.

Print Process

Lubes'n'Greases is four-color sheet-fed offset printed on coated stock.

Paper

Lubes'n'Greases is printed on 70 pound and 60 pound #3 sheet.

Trim Size (finished dimensions)

8 3/8 inches horizontal x 10 7/8 inches vertical (212.725 mm x 276.225 mm).

Color

Use only standard process colors (cyan, magenta, yellow, black). All colors are four-color process screen builds. We will screen build to match Pantone PMS colors. DO NOT USE RGB. Use device dependent color settings (with no ICC Profiles).

Ink Coverage, Line Thickness

Ink coverage must be less than 310 percent. Line thickness must be greater than 0.25 points.

Bleeds

Minimum 1/8 inch (3.175 mm) bleed required on all edges that bleed.

Printer's Marks

Remove all printer's marks (crop marks, registration, bleed marks, color bars, and page information) from the ad.

Digital Files

Only high-resolution electronic PDF files, minimum 300 dpi, with all fonts embedded in all subsets, are accepted. Negatives are not accepted. Other software, such as QuarkXPress, Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Word or PowerPoint, are not accepted. Please note: on-screen anomalies in digital files may also appear in the digital editions.

File Size

Do not email files over 10 MB in size. Contact Lubes'n'Greases for instructions for sending 10 MB and larger files.

Full-page Ads

For all full page ads, set page size equal to bleed dimensions. Bleed dimensions are 8 5/8 inches horizontal x 11 1/8 inches vertical (219.075 mm x 282.575 mm). Set trim box to finished dimensions: 8 3/8 inches horizontal x 10 7/8 inches vertical (212.725 mm x 276.225 mm).

Fractional Ads

The shape of Half- or Third-Page fractional ads must be confirmed by the Ad Close Date of the issue. Please note that Lubes'n'Greases may add a thin black rule or stroke to fractional ads that appear to float on a white background. This is done to help separate the ad from other ads or editorial.

Spreads

Two-page spreads must be submitted as two separate full-page bleed ads. When designing art account for trim, and crossover at the gutter.

Advertorial

Ads that resemble editorial must include the word "Advertisement" at the top of each page in legible, minimum 9 point font.

Proofs

SWOP-approved color proofs for Lubes'n'Greases (provided by the advertiser) are required to check for accuracy on press.

Meeting Distribution Sponsorship

Advertisers who sponsor distribution at selected industry meetings must supply preprinted, stick-on labels (crack-and-peel preferred) for front page impact. Contact us for prices and label specifications.

Gatefolds, Inserts, Supplements

Gatefold ads, advertising inserts and custom advertising supplements are available. Email or call for pricing and specifications

Classified Ads

Price includes simple typesetting, headline and digital proof. Graphic elements, alterations or other production work will be charged at prevailing rates. Color classified ads are charged at display rates.

Production Charges

All rates are per insertion, in U.S. dollars, and are based on the advertiser supplying complete electronic files and proofs which meet Lubes'n'Greases' specifications by the published deadlines.

In the absence of final, press ready ad materials production services are available and will be billed at prevailing rates. Email or call for price quote. \$50 minimum.

Changes made to ad materials after the published deadlines may incur a production fee.

Dimensions are based on the publication's 2-, 3- and 4-column grid. Do not exceed the stated space. Any fractional ads that are slightly under the stated dimensions will be centered within the contracted space.

Trim Size

Finished dimensions of the magazine is 8 3/8 inches wide x 10 7/8 inches high (212.725 mm x 276.225 mm).

Double Page Spread

Submit as two separate full-page bleed ads. Live area is 16 inches wide x 10 inches high (406.4 x 254 mm).
